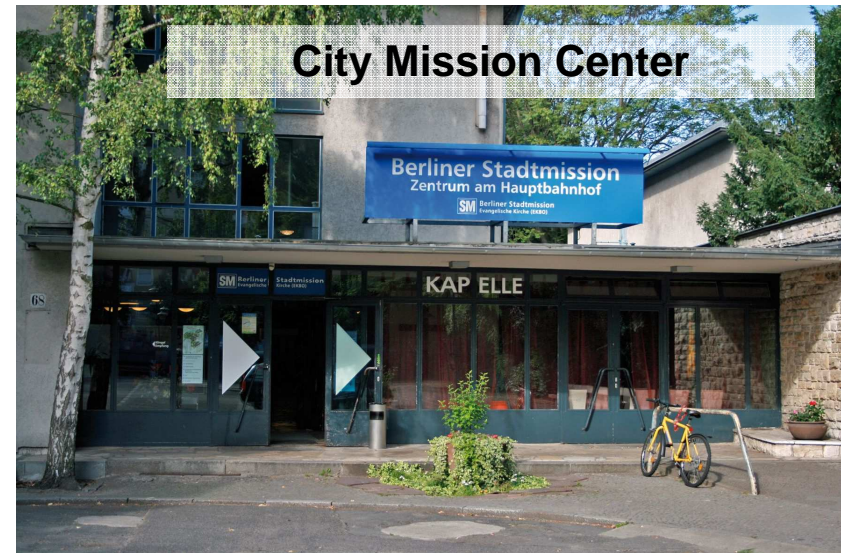

Berliner Stadtmission



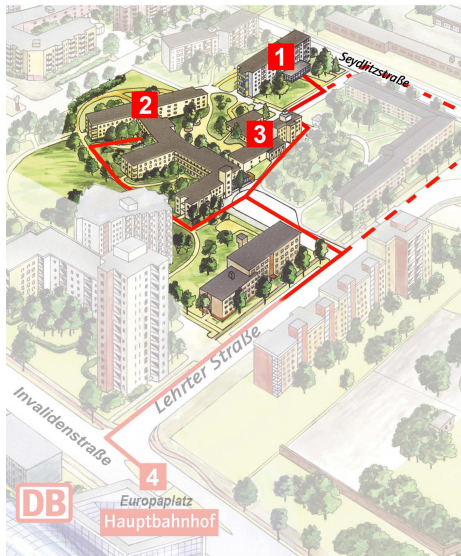
Berlin, the capital of Germany, has 3,4 million inhabitants. As a result of the division of the city and the decades-long influence of Communism, only 29 % of Berliners belong to a Christian church. Berlin also faces big social challenges due to the city history, its fast growth processes, unemployment, migration etc. Statistics for example speak of 10,000 homeless persons in the city.

The "Berliner Stadtmission" (Berlin City Mission) has accepted the challenge and serves the city in an extraordinary way: As a sign of hope we have established a City Mission Center near to Berlin's Central Station called "Zentrum am Hauptbahnhof". Right in the heart of the city and geographically located between Germany's biggest prison and the government complexes, this center is

comprised of all of our main areas of work in one location:
Mission – Social Work – Encounters.



Hans-Georg Filker, director of the Berliner Stadtmission (Berlin City Mission) and Vice-President of the City Mission World Association (CMWA) is aware of the urgent need for evangelization and social assistance. "Mission is possible" he proclaims – and what is already happening in the Christian center makes clear that he is right: Homeless people get food and medical help, visitors find hospitality in a guest house with 450 beds, handicapped persons receive assistance, and prisoners get re-integrated into society. The poor as well as the rich, people from all walks of life, get in contact with the Gospel and experience God's love in practical ways.

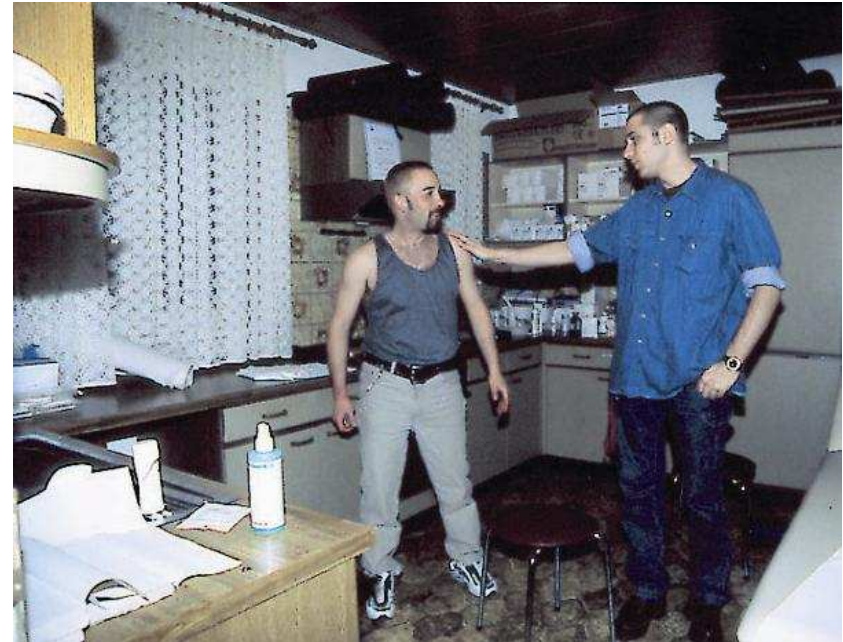
Projects at the City Mission Center

The location of the Center is a blessing: close to the main railway station with more than 300,000 passengers travelling daily, and within walking distance to the government's quarters.

This center with the four houses on 27,000 square meters still provides many more possibilities to influence city life in a positive way. Help (faith-based social work) and love are shared in an exemplary way with urban people in a postmodern world.
